#### ALL H-D AND METRICS WITH HOLES IN THE BRAKE PEDALS

**STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

**STEP 2** Remove the stock brake lever cover. Peel the rubber off the lever or remove the acorn nut and washer. Set the cover and hardware aside, it will not be reused.

**STEP 3** Slide the Flamin' Brake Pedal cover (without rubber pad) over the brake lever and align the hole that applies to your applications. See <u>PIC. 1</u>.

**STEP 4** Put the 3/8-16 x 7/8" Hex Head Cap Screw into the brake cover from the top. Reinstall the rubber pad and pull rubber darts through. You may need to use a needle nose pliers to pull the darts completely through. Use a side cutter to remove the excess rubber darts to ensure proper fitment. See PIC. 2.



**STEP 5** Tighten the brake cover putting the flat washer on followed by the acorn nut.

**STEP 6** Ensure proper clearance and operation before riding the motorcycle.

## METRIC BIKES THAT REQUIRE DRILLING OF THE BRAKE LEVER

**STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

**STEP 2** Remove the stock brake lever cover. Peel the rubber off the lever or remove the acorn nut and washer. Set the cover and hardware aside, it will not be reused.

**STEP 3** Put the cover in place on your brake lever and mark out the center hole that needs to be drilled.

**STEP 4** Use a center punch to mark the exact center of the hole to be drilled. The final bit size needs to be 3/8". You may want to use smaller pilot bits to start out with.

**STEP 5** Drill the hole and remove any metal shavings.

**STEP 6** Put the 3/8-16 x 7/8" Hex Head Cap Screw through the top of the brake cover and through the hole you just drilled. Reinstall the rubber pad and pull rubber darts through. You may need to use a needle nose pliers to pull the darts completely through. Use a side cutter to remove the excess rubber darts to ensure proper fitment. See <u>PIC. 2</u>.

**STEP 7** Install the brake cover on to the brake lever and secure it with the washer and acorn nut.

**STEP 8** Ensure proper clearance and operation before riding the motorcycle.
